









Cosmetics & Toiletries	Expiration	Advice
<p>Body, Skin, Hair, products</p> 	<p>Unopened = most can last <b>2-3 years</b></p>	<p><i>Color cosmetics have a shorter life span because the pigments cannot stay suspended for that length of time: <b>1- 1<sup>1/2</sup> years</b></i></p>
<p>Body Wash &amp; Bar Soap</p> 	<p><b>3 years</b> is the average life span of both soap bars and body wash <b>unopened</b></p>	<p><i>Natural soaps will expire before commercial ones.</i></p>
<p>Cologne &amp; Perfumes</p> 	<p><b>Do not Expire</b></p> <p><i>However average shelf life of fragrance is <b>3-5 years</b></i></p>	
<p>Deodorant</p> 	<p>Unopened = 1-3 years after purchase date</p> <p><u>Opened</u> = replace every <b>6-12 months</b></p>	
<p>Foundation, Primer, Blush, &amp; Eyeshadow</p> 	<p>Unopened = Can last up to <b>2 years</b></p> <p>Opened = can last up to <b>2 years</b></p>	<p><i>The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) don't offer any guidelines nor does the agency require manufacturers to establish expiration dates. It may be helpful to write the date you opened</i></p>
<p>Hair Brush</p> 	<p>General Rule: <b>6 months – 1 year</b></p> <p><i>Depends on the quality of brush, how often it's used, and how much product is involved.</i></p>	
<p>Lipstick</p> 	<p>Is good for <b>one year</b> after it's opened</p>	

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Lotions</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Unopened and sealed = 3 years</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Unopened lotions last slightly longer than opened products. As a rule of thumb, if you open a new or old bottle of lotion and it looks or smells bad, you should throw it away.</i></p>	<p><i>The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) don't offer any guidelines nor does the agency require manufacturers to establish expiration dates.</i></p> <p>Lotions also have suggested timeframes for when to use the product after it's been open — this can range anywhere between 12 and 24 months.</p> <p><i>It may be helpful to write the date you opened the lotion directly on the container with permanent marker so you'll know when to toss it.</i></p>
 <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mascara &amp; Eyeliner</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Replace every <b>3 months</b></p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Natural Products</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Has a shelf life of <b>3-6 months</b></p>	<p><i>Preservative free cosmetics, similar to food, can be kept in your refrigerator and they'll last longer.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Tooth Brushes</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Replace <b>every 3-4 months</b> or when bristles appear to be worn out</p>	<p><i>When the tooth brush bristles lose their stiffness is when they are ready for trash...Try to replace around the same time –mark on calendar date of purchase to help you remember.</i></p>
